The greatest measure of success is effort not ability and requires engagement, commitment, resilience and a growth mindset.

We therefore encourage the children of Canberra to engage and commit to their learning at all times. We reward engagement and commitment through our certificates which are presented at assembly each week. The language of success and commitment is used regularly throughout the school day by all members of staff.

Children are encouraged to recognise that the harder they work the greater the reward. To further enable their success we have invested in growth Mindset training for the whole school, including training for parents, which will take place in February 2019.

We also encourage our children to commit to their extra-curricular activities and to take on extra responsibilities within the school e.g. P6 lunch monitors. These activities help them to develop and practice skills which will enhance their lifelong learning.

All class teachers have been focusing this term on pupil engagement through teaching observations, as part of the school's improvement processes. The findings have resulted in changes to planning, organisation and motivational strategies being used in classes.

Primary 5 will be piloting the use of the Leuven Scale to help children to understand the power and importance of engagement in learning. They will present their findings in a child friendly way to the whole school and will take a lead role in supporting classes to adopt this measure.
