# **Tip Corner**

### Handwriting (2)

A good pencil grip and the correct amount of pressure is very important to ensuring legible handwriting.

The best way to hold a pen or pencil is to let it rest next to the base of your thumb. Hold it in place with your thumb, and your index and middle finger. If your child finds this tricky they can hold a small pompom or coin with their ring and pinky finger to help them position their fingers correctly.

The grip needs to be relaxed and slowing down the speed of writing can help with letter formation. Lined paper is a great way to help your child practice the size of their letters.

## Parent and child consultation

We found that the sharing of information with both children and their parents at our consultations in October ensured that everyone was on the same page with regards to learning and behaviour. This has helped children to understand what they need to do to improve and allowed their progress to be clear to them.

We are holding a second parent and child consultation on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> February. A letter providing more information will be sent out towards the end of January.

### Respect

At Canberra we talk about respect all the time as it is cornerstone of our school ethos. When our children show respect to each other and the adults in the school community behaviour and the learning environment are improved.

They are more able to manage challenging aspects in their learning or their social interactions when they are confident that they are respected.

We also focus on self-respect and the importance of having high standards of behaviour and work ethic.

Children are reminded at assembly and during class about the importance of respect and they can describe clearly what respect looks and sounds like. They understand that respect is a two way street and that treating others respectfully will result in respectful treatment from others.

House points are given to children demonstrating respect in class, around the school and in the playground.
